Scott White Contemporary Art presents *Containment/Release*, a solo exhibition by celebrated San Diego artist Robert Treat.

The opening reception will take place on Friday, January 14 from 6:00 – 8:00 p.m. in conjunction with *Kettner Nights*. Light refreshments will be served.

EXHIBITION DETAILS:

Scott White Contemporary Art presents the exhibition *Containment/Release* by San Diego based artist Robert Treat. This is Treat's first solo exhibition at Scott White Contemporary Art. His new works are the product of a continued interest in the surface and process of encaustic wax painting. Treat explores the idea of linear containment in both the painting's composition, as well as the painting as a contained object itself. Building upon his roots in abstraction, Treat has combined his intuition and logic to create a visceral, yet thoughtfully planned experience through this new body of work.

Containment/Release will feature approximately 10 medium to large-scale encaustic paintings on canvas as well as 4 small works on paper.

ARTIST INFORMATION:

Robert Treat earned a B.F.A. at Miami University in Oxford, Ohio, later pursuing graduate studies at University of Cincinnati in Cincinnati, Ohio and the Columbus College of Art and Design in Columbus, Ohio.
